GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

1. Entry Fee is \$50.00 for TD test including AKC recording fee and event fee. Notice to Exhibitors: A recording fee of .50 and event service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.
2. Closing date for entries is NOON, Thursday April 5, 2012 after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or changed.
3. Mail all entries of dogs that have not earned a TD title, with an original written statement of certification dated within 1 year of the date of the test signed by an approved or provisional tracking judge, with fees to: Jane E Murphy, 2860 Sorrel Way, Eugene, OR 97401. For other delivery call test secretary for instructions. Make checks or money orders payable to EDOC.
4. A random drawing will take place: Thursday, April 5, 2012 at the EDOC building located at 1000 Obie St., Eugene, OR at 2:30 pm. Please call or email Test Secretary for directions to draw site.
5. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as possible after the

drawing. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please email secretary at JaneM1@comcast.net.

6. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
7. Only one entry per dog will be accepted. Please do not mail additional entries. They will be returned.
8. Dogs who have not earned their TD will have priority for the draw.
9. Test worker Option: At the draw four (4) tracks will be set aside per Chapter 1, Section 13d. Test worker is defined as an EDOC club member in good standing who served test chair, test secretary, test committee or tracklayer at any EDOC tracking test in 2010 or 2011.
10. An alternate list will be maintained for the TD Test. No entry fees will be refunded unless an alternate is present and runs on the absent dog's track. Entry fees of an alternate that does not compete shall be refunded. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, the Tracking Test Secretary shall determine if any alternates are present, and the available track(s) shall be assigned in the order in which alternate entries were drawn.
11. Refund Policy: The entry fee will be refunded if either 1) the entrant notifies the secretary prior to the draw for tracks and an alternate runs the track, or 2) the dog is an alternate who does not run a track.
12. All dogs and handlers entered must be at the Tracking Test area by 7:00 AM on Sunday, April 5, 2012, at which time there will be a drawing for track order.
13. Judging will start as soon as the first track has aged the required time.
14. BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE under the conditions specified in the AKC Tracking Regulations.
15. Extreme weather conditions: The AKC believes the well being of dogs and participants are of paramount importance. In the case of adverse weather conditions, the test could be canceled and rescheduled.
16. EDOC offers each passing dog a wooden plaque with a map of their track.
17. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.
18. This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
19. DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE: I-5 Exit 195B. Follow Beltline to where it ends at W.11th (Hwy 126). Turn right (west). At Greenhill (Signal), turn left. Greenhill becomes Crow Rd. Follow to 2nd Dukhobar Rd intersection. Turn right and proceed to test headquarters. There is no overnight camping on the grounds. This is private property. Please do not arrive prior to 6:45 AM.
