GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

1. **Entry Fee:** \$90 payable in US dollars. Entry fee includes a \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event fee. Make checks payable to EDOC.
2. **Closing Date:** Entries will be accepted until 5:00 PM, Wednesday September 17, 2008 after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. All entries must be delivered to Nola Ventura, 84965 McBeth Road, Eugene, OR 97405
3. For other delivery options call test secretary for instructions. Make checks or money orders payable to EDOC. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
4. **Drawing for Entries:** This test is limited to 5 dogs. A random drawing will take place Wednesday, September 17, 2008, at the regularly scheduled meeting of Emerald Dog Obedience Club, located at the EPUD Building, Seavey Loop, Eugene, OR. Call or email the Test Secretary for directions to draw site. When the limit is reached, the drawing will continue and an alternate list will be established in the order in which entries are drawn.
5. **Notification:** Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as

possible after the drawing. If the exhibitor does not receive acknowledgment within a reasonable time, call 541-338-0677 or email nventura@uoregon.edu.

6. **Eligibility for Entries:** Preference for entry is dogs who have not yet passed an AKC TDX test.
7. **Draw for Running Order 10:00 AM:** Handlers must be at the Tracking Test area by 10:00 AM on Sunday, October 12, 2008, at which time there will be a drawing for track order. Entrants not present at the time of drawing for tracks may be marked absent and an alternate allowed to run in their place.
8. **Start of Judging:** Judging will start as soon as the first track has aged the required time. Test Hours: 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
9. **Refund Policy:** The entry fee will be refunded if either 1) the entrant notifies the secretary prior to the draw for tracks and an alternate runs the track, or 2) the dog is an alternate who does not run a track.
10. **Bitches in Season:** Bitches in season may participate in this test. If your bitch is in season, when you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle well away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track will be reserved for your bitch. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate only after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. Bitches in season must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.
11. **Directions to Test Site:** From I-5 take exit 174 (Cottage Grove). Turn right and then bear right at the Y. Proceed to Hwy 99. Turn left. Hwy 99 becomes 9th St, which then becomes Cottage Grove-Lorane Rd. Go approximately 4.8 miles. You will pass Overholser Rd and then you will look for the first driveway on the right. Look for EDOC Signs.
12. **Extreme Weather Conditions:** The AKC believes the well being of dogs and participants are of paramount importance. In the case of adverse weather conditions, the test could be canceled and rescheduled.
13. **Awards:** EDOC offers each passing dog a wooden plaque with a map of its track.
14. **AKC Rules:** All entrants are responsible for complying with the AKC rules regarding Tracking Tests and other AKC rules referred to in the Tracking Test Rule book.
15. **Post Test Brunch:** A no-host celebration will be held after the test at the Koffee Kup Restaurant. All are invited to attend.

PLEASE NOTE: There is no overnight camping on the grounds. This is private property. Do not arrive prior to 9:00 AM. Hotel information will be included with entry confirmation.
